

Synopsis

A military mission turned wrong, Corporal Parker is being held accountable for the death of one of his fellow brothers in arms, however he remembers the mission far differently.

I felt like the story behind Tango was one that needed to be told. As I have moved through life and worked in various fields I have made many friends that have served our country proudly, however many of them never get the treatment and support they ultimately need to cope with daily life once they return home. These soldiers are taught how to kill and fight, but with the flip of a switch told to act "normal" and deal with the experiences they witnessed. This film depicts the tip of an iceberg about Post Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD). Unfortunately many that truly deal with this condition prefer not to seek treatment due to the stigma of their suffering

Production Notes



Taking on this challenge I was afraid that without an extensive amount of research I could not do justice to the subject matter. Thankfully I had a close friend who had served in the military, had deployed several times overseas fighting in the current conflicts and wars, and he was able to provide accurate insight and vivid details of first hand experiences that helped me correctly depict the military elements to the best of my ability and budget. I am really thankful to UT Arlington for helping me obtain the necessary documents to acquire the location for the action scenes. The property used happened to be the same location used by the TV show Prison Break for several

Prop guns and other elements were donated by previous servicemen to help provide the accurate weapons and attire to outfit the men. Active role playing military assistants volunteered as extras so their actions and movements would mimic real manuvers.



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
